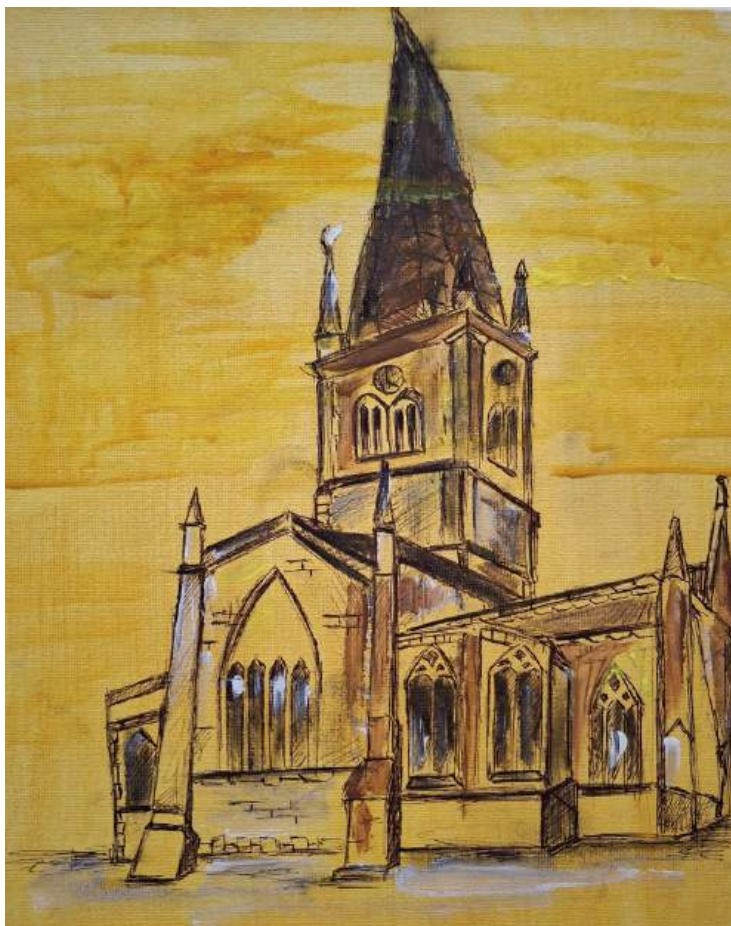

Introduction

The art in this exhibition was created in our activity groups by the people who access our service. The groups are a huge asset to Pathways, attendees have built a supportive community and people often refer to it being like a family. It is a pleasure to see people grow in confidence and push themselves out of their comfort zones and support each other.

So often, in this line of work, people are asked what their needs are and what will help them, which is important, but when these are often the main or only questions asked of you, it can impact your self-esteem.

The Pathways Art Exhibition and Silent Auction wants to showcase the amazing talent and creativity these individuals have, rather than seeing what support needs they have. We want you to see what brilliant skills these Artists have to offer.

Silent Auction– How it works

The silent auction will take place both at the exhibition and via email for the week after the event. Bidding slips or emails will be submitted with the lot number and title (available in the exhibition brochure), your bid amount and contact details. Once the auction closes on Wednesday 23rd September, the highest bid for each piece will be notified and payment details confirmed.

All payments will be made to the Pathways of Chesterfield bank account or by cash or card at 106 Saltergate. Once payment has been received artwork will be available for collection.

Delivery will be available at an additional cost. This can be confirmed upon confirmation of being the highest bidder on any pieces of artwork. You're welcome to include that you would need delivery on your initial bidding slip so the delivery cost can be calculated and notified at the point of confirming the winning bid but this isn't essential.

- Auction open from 9am Wednesday 16th September until Midnight Wednesday 23rd September
- All winning bids will be notified week commencing Monday 28th September.

The Importance of Groups

- Social connections – building social networks with others in group can relieve loneliness
- Structure, regular routine and consistency keeps people on track to reach their goals
- A safe, warm and nonjudgmental space for all to enjoy
- Varied activities are offered to suit everyone, which relieves boredom and can help break habits
- Support from staff and volunteers such as signposting to other agencies, housing, tenancy support, and mental health support
- Opportunities for us to safeguard vulnerable adults as we have regular contact
- Mediation or interventions – we spend time talking and mainly listening in group and can intervene when concerns or problems arise
- Develop skills – learning something new is great for your mental well being
- Build self-esteem – creating something or contributing to project brings the feel-good factor
- Improves physical fitness
- Improves mood and help combat anxiety and depression
- Improves quality of sleep
- Encourages involvement with the local community in events and activities
- Combats pessimism – having volunteers and peer mentors with lived experience attending group can show that change and a positive outcome is possible
- Hot meals and refreshments are included for the people we work with who struggle financially. A hot meal can make such a difference

Collaboratively we discussed and decided which words to use, and the image was somewhat poignant with the past being painted over and leaving behind a new life to fight for. 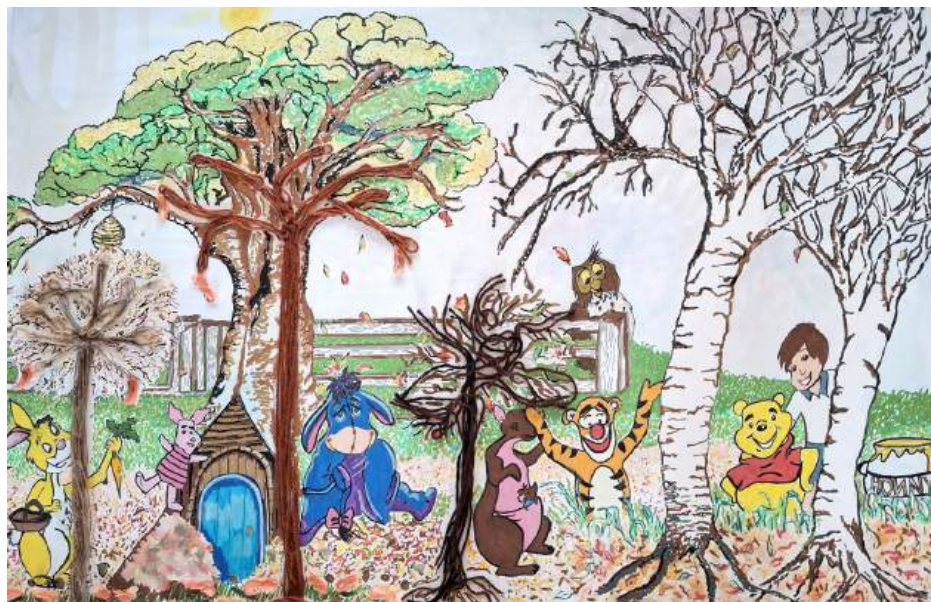

Silhouettes

Our group was given the brief to create silhouette art using acrylic paint. We explored different examples of silhouette artwork and experimented with shapes, colours and compositions before developing our final idea.

We used acrylic paint to create strong contrast between the background and the silhouettes, focusing on bold colours and clear shapes. Throughout the project we worked collaboratively, sharing ideas and helping each other develop the final compositions.

One of the main challenges was creating clean, recognisable silhouettes whilst keeping the artwork visually interesting. This helped us improve our painting skills, particularly with brush control and creating sharp edges.

Overall we were pleased with the finished pieces. The project allowed us to work creatively as a group whilst developing our confidence and skills with acrylic paint.

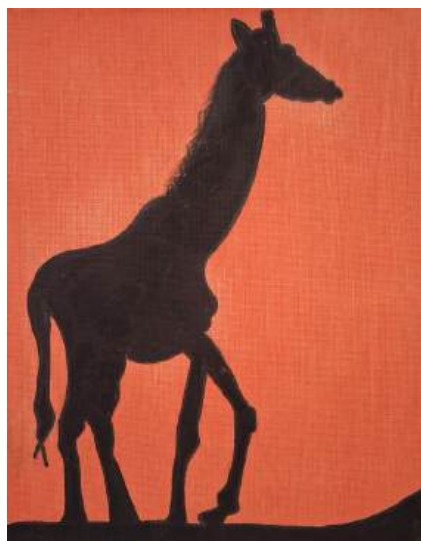

Awesome Women

Pathways Women's Group is a weekly 'women's only' activity group which provides a safe and relaxing space for homeless women and vulnerable women in our community. It has been running for over 18 months now and has proven to be life-changing for many of the attendees.

Reducing isolation and loneliness, increasing confidence and self-esteem is always paramount when providing a group such as ours. Our ladies often tell us how Pathways saved them, how it has given them a sense of purpose and something to look forward to each week. Our group has given people another choice, to get out and be with others in a positive environment, completely judgement free.

Many of our attendees have had children removed from their care, these traumatic events are never far from their minds and have left colossal wounds. Being able to talk about such a difficult topic brings up lots of painful emotions but sharing experiences and talking openly removes some of the stigma attached.

Our Women's only Drop-in service is now part of our weekly calendar, and it has proven to be invaluable, this originally started due to the need brought to light by our Women's Group. It means vulnerable women and children in our community can access Pathways safely in a non-threatening environment.

We have enjoyed jewelry making, doing our women in history project, soap making, book club, needle felting, dream catcher making and fascinator making. The collaborative artwork has brought much joy to our ladies who genuinely love creating pieces together but mainly enjoy each other's company, the support that they have given one another has been heartwarming.

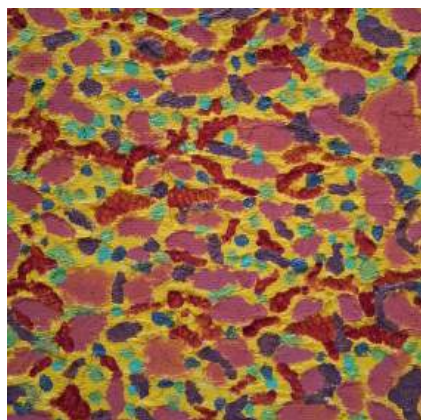

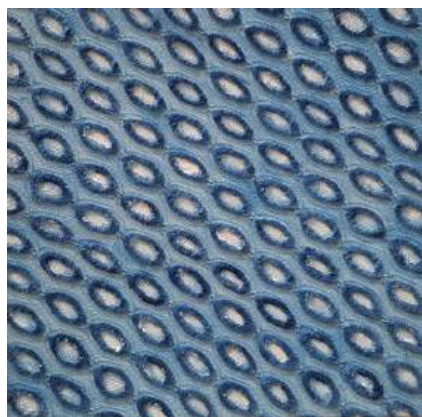

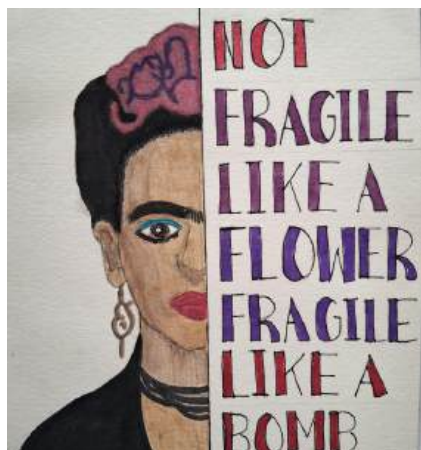

Tracey

Back in January 2024, Tracey was referred to us by Trent PTS and Derbyshire Recovery Partnership to become involved in our groups as part of her recovery journey.

At the time, Tracey was experiencing anxiety, depression and PTSD and needed more structure, routine and positive focus in her life. Through our support, Tracey was able to access practical help alongside opportunities to build her confidence, wellbeing and sense of purpose.

We supported Tracey with bills while she was housed and referred her to the Wise Group for further support with managing debts and accessing grants. When Tracey needed a cooker, the Wise Group helped her obtain one, removing a practical barrier and helping her feel more settled at home.

Tracey initially attended our Women's Group before progressing to our Art and Wellbeing Group. Through art, she found a positive way to express herself, connect with others and continue building confidence as part of her recovery.

Since then, Tracey has gone from being a participant in our groups to becoming a valued member of the team. She now **volunteers at our Wellbeing Group every week**, supporting others and helping to create a welcoming and positive environment.

Once a month, Tracey also shares her skills and knowledge by **teaching clients about creative writing** within the Wellbeing Group. Her willingness to give back and support others is a wonderful reflection of how far she has come.

Tracey is a **friendly, approachable and supportive member of the team**, always willing to have a chat, encourage others and share her creativity. As well as being an amazing artist, she brings warmth, kindness and enthusiasm to everything she does.

Tracey’s journey is a fantastic example of how support, connection and creativity can help someone move forward in their recovery. We are incredibly proud of the progress she has made and the positive impact she now has on others.

We’re delighted to shine a spotlight on Tracey and celebrate her incredible journey from accessing support to inspiring and supporting others through her creativity.

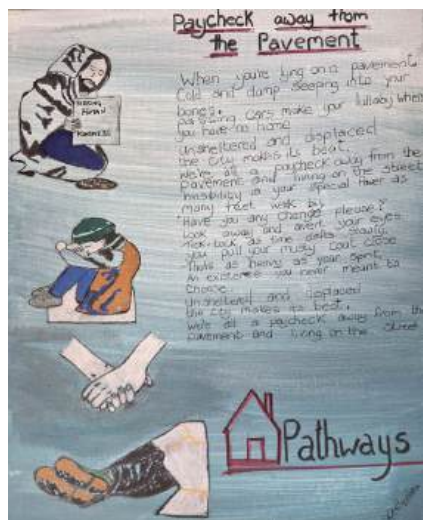

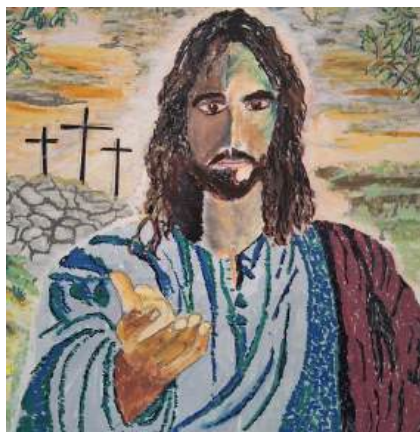

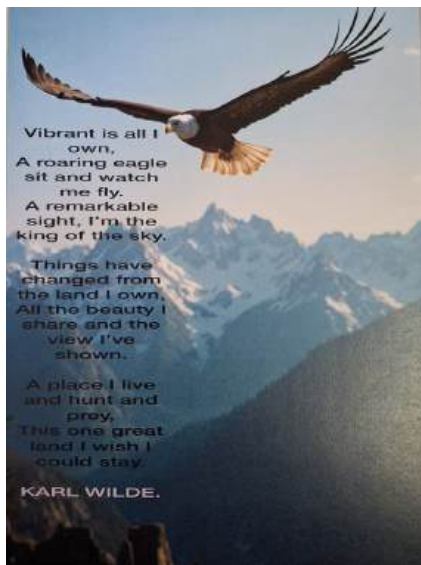
